- Offers leadership training, professional and academic development, mentoring opportunities, community service outreach programs and scholarships
- One of the largest student-managed society, with more than 310 chapters divided into six regions and governed by a national executive board
- Has approximately 30,000 collegiate and professional members, including more than 10,000 pre-college students
- NSBE programs include career fairs, graduate school fairs, technical research projects, academic competitions, scholarships, retention and awards.
- Hosts 18 regional conferences, a national leadership conference, an international conference and an annual convention that draws nearly 10,000 attendees
- NSBE produces two publications: *NSBE Magazine* and *NSBE Bridge* magazine
- NSBE is supported by a Board of Corporate Affiliates and other major corporate and government sponsors
- A professional staff of 29 operates the NSBE World Headquarters Office, located in Alexandria, Va.
